Mr. Mulvaney gave his Superintendent's Report. He stated that we are searching for a math teacher due to Mrs. Young's resignation. We are installing new carpet in the teachers' lounge and the band room. Tax money from Vermilion County has been received by the school early this year. The school bought a new mini van for Drivers' Education. Our 30-day CDs at the Gifford State Bank were increased to 1.5% interest rate.

Mr. Loschen gave his Principal's Report. He stated that registration for school is August 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>. August 20, 2018 is the first day of school for our students. The high school expects 134 students for the 2018-2019 school year; the class breakdown is expected as follows: 29 freshmen, 29 sophomores, 35 juniors, 41 seniors. He also discussed student handbook changes.
