Tie Breaks to determine champion

- 2-Way -- Head-to-head winner
- 3-Way -- A) Use a point differential -- 10 maximum per game -- in games among tied teams only. If this creates a 2-way tie, use head-to-head.
- B) If a 3-way tie still exists, use point differential -- 10 maximum per game -- in all games. If this creates a 2-way tie, use head-to-head.
- C) If a 3-way tie still exists, use free throw percentage in all games. If this creates a two-way tie, use head-to-head.
- D) In the unlikely event that a three-way tie still exists, use a coin flip.

*highest point total
